



Pick a Theme: Be bold, be quirky, or be classic-just make it awesome!


Daily Touch-Ups: Work on your tree little by little every day. No rush, no stress, just pure holiday vibes.

DRESS CODE: DRESS TO IMPRESS


BYOB (BRING YOUR OWN BOOZE) PARTY
